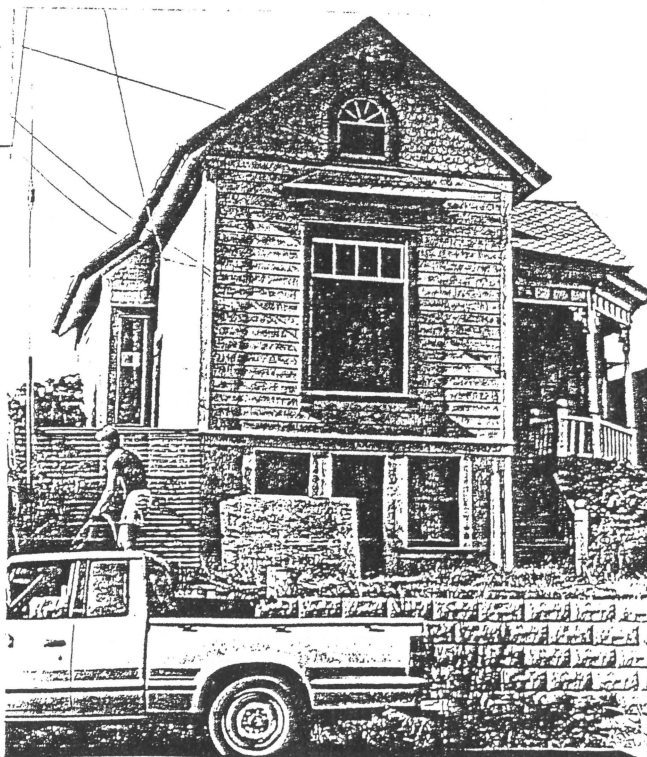

This two story L plan residence with a cross gable roof is an elegant example of Eastlake architecture. The front facade of the house displays a large gable end with a hooded window and an arched window to the ocean. Next to the gable is a recessed covered porch. East lake pendants are applied under the pendant of the gable, next to the table leg porch supports and under the window hood and moldings. Textured shingle and clapboard are used for sheathing.

This house is an excellent example of modest Eastlake architecture. Its prominent beachside location indicates it may have been a resort residence of some stature.

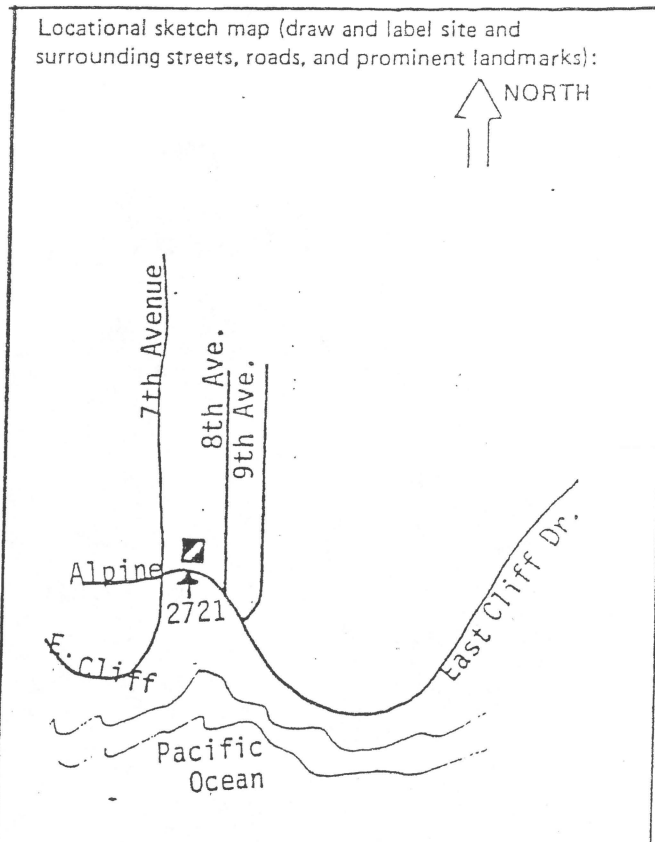
