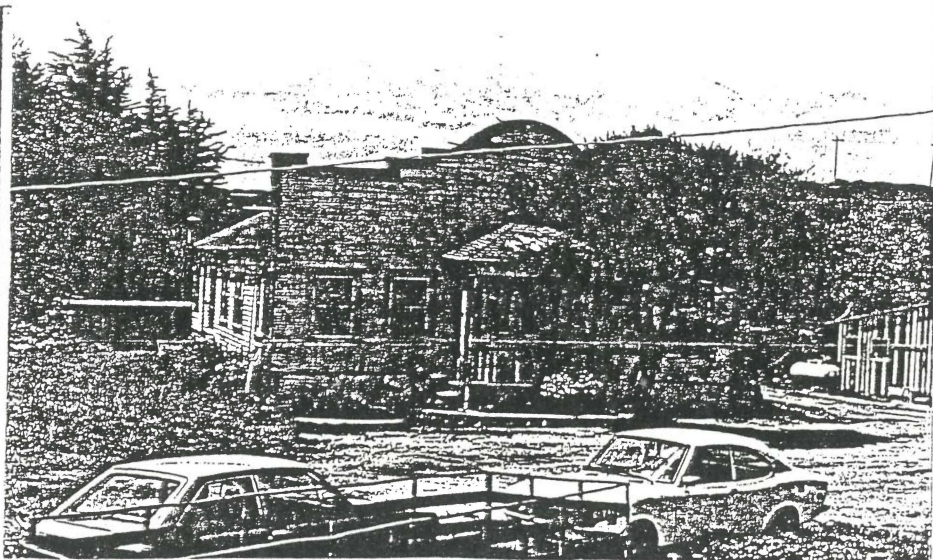

DESCRIPTION

- 7a. Architectural style: Mission Revival - Wood
- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

A rectangular single story building with a low pitched roof behind a false front. The false front is a Mission Revival design with corner "piers" and a stepped then flat arched center element. A small circular decorative element is above the center double doors. Paired windows with flat board frames and double hung sash are on each side of the facade. A small porch and hipped roof complete the entry and front facade. Sheathing is narrow horizontal lapped siding, and is punctuated by an even pattern of double hung wood frame windows on each side. Faded, almost illegible signs for gas and supplies can be seen on the front facade. The building appears to be original in exterior design and materials. The interior appears divided into residential units.

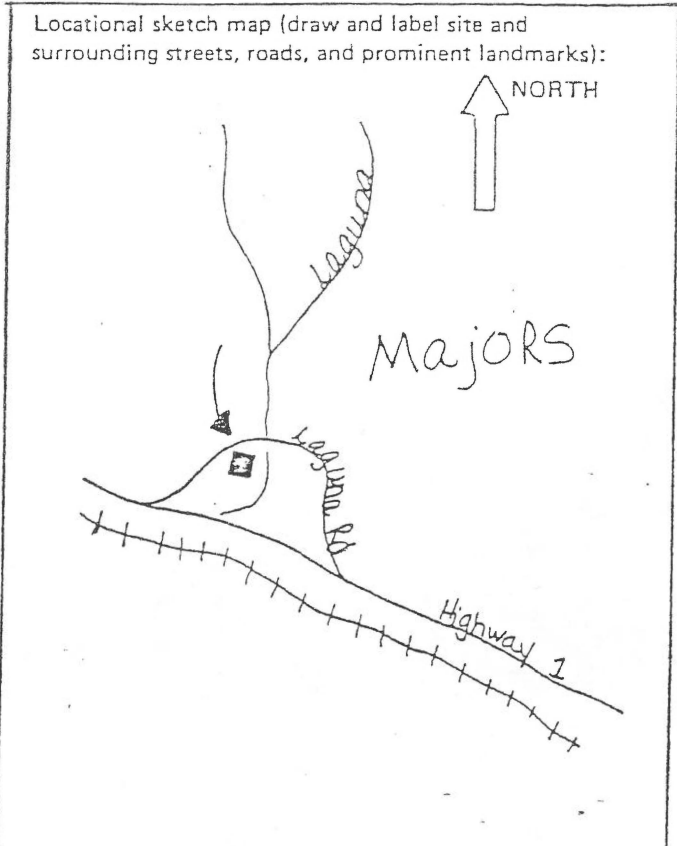
