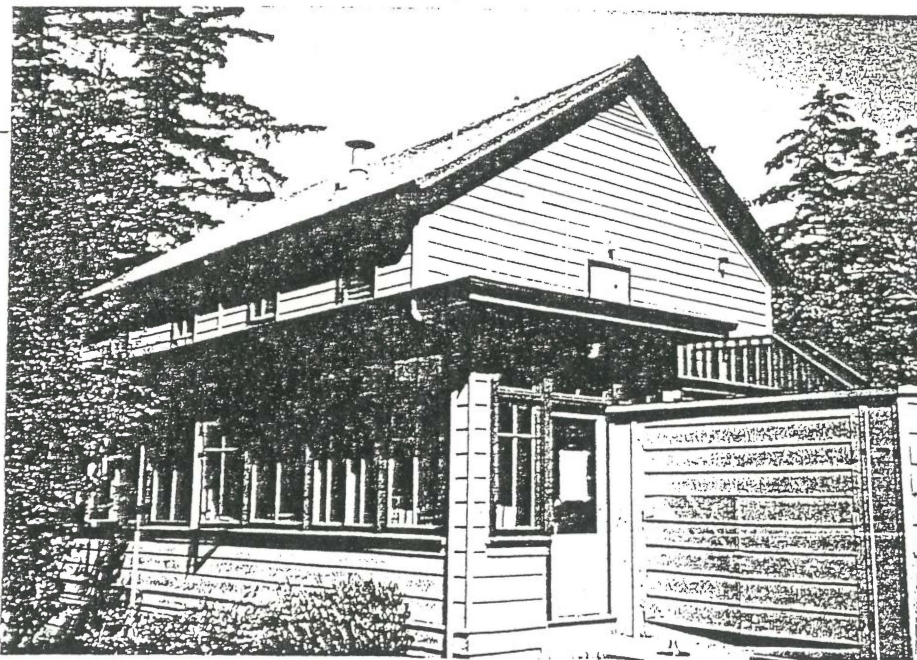

- 7b. Briefly describe the present physical appearance of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

A rectangular one and a half story structure (two living levels) with enclosed porch. The porch wraps on two sides of the structure. The medium pitched roof creates an end facing gable front entry facade. The entry stairs, slightly off center, have half wall sides faced in a wide channel horizontal board as in the entire structure. Fenestration is irregular except for the row of windows enclosing the porch. There is no ornamentation or distinctive style elements a part of this structure. Additions and modifications have been made over the years.

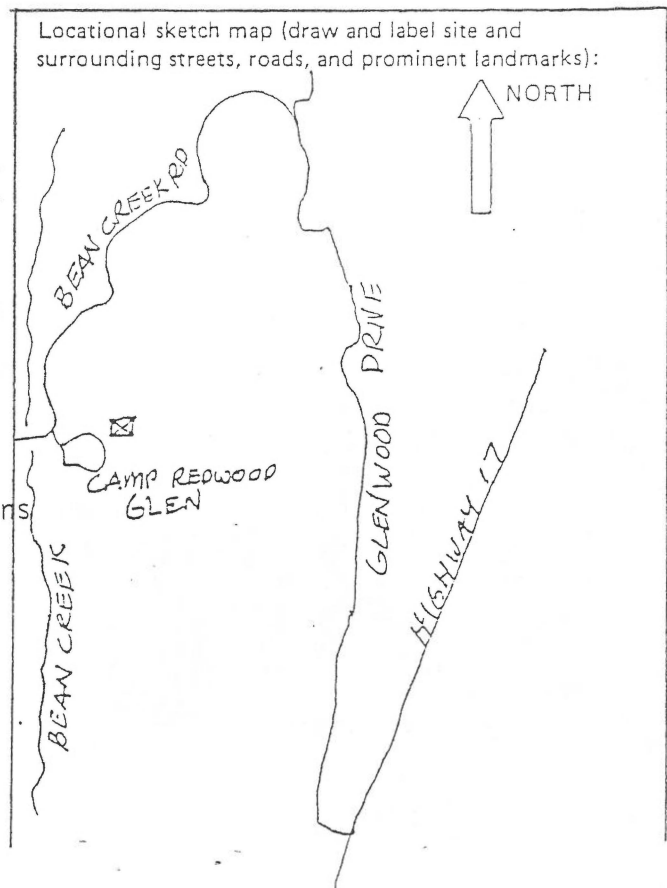
