DESCRIPTION

- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

This elegant structure is a large two-story, two-plan house with a gabled roof and a corbelled brick interior chimney. It has a large dormer with a heavy cornice and tall narrow, double-hung windows. All of the other windows on the house are of the same type, but additionally decorated with cornices on top and small brackets beneath, characteristic of Greek Revival architecture. The ship-lap siding and overall simplicity, elegance and vertical proportions of this house are other features indicative of Greek Revival architecture.

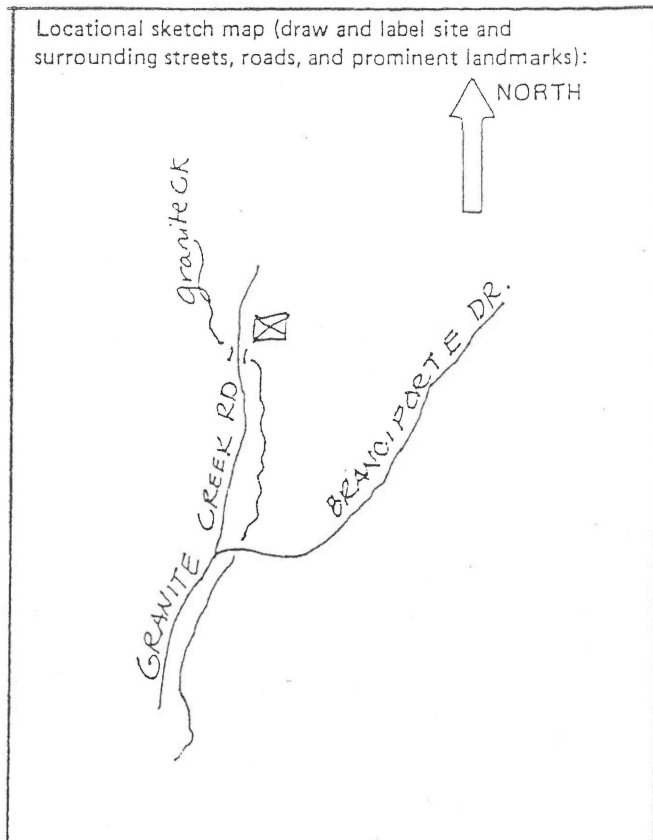
SIGNIFICANCE

19. Briefly state historical and/or architectural importance (include dates, events, and persons associated with the site.)
 This residence is notable as an example of Greek Revival architecture. Greek Revival architecture was concerned with the transformation of the basic Greek Temple motifs into wooden buildings using simple vertical proportions and classical trim in the form of cornices, pilasters, brackets and other moldings. Greek Revival was most popular from the 1840's to the 1860's, but occurs as late as the 1870's, in the Santa Cruz area.

ADDENDUM—1994

PHYSICAL INSPECTION

Date: November 17, 1993

Result of Inspection: This structure now has a large modern addition on the side. It is not possible to tell from the 1986 photograph whether the addition was constructed since the last survey. The addition compromises the integrity of the original structure and would make it ineligible for the National Register of Historic Places although it still has local significance.

CONSULTANT'S PRELIMINARY RECOMMENDATIONS:

Structure should be rated 5.
